**DESCRIPTION:** Shamrock Lake is a 62-acre manmade public lake located within the geographical boundaries of the City of Clare. Fish were once plentiful in the lake and the site was a favorite for local fishermen and women. Today the lake is inundated with silt. Fish habitat has reduced greatly over time and an ecosystem restoration project is desired.
