

**PROJECT:** Walled Lake, Michigan - Section 205 (C-CAP)

**DESCRIPTION:** The City of Walled Lake is 2.9 square miles and located in Southwest Oakland County. The City is home to 6,713 residents. The City has requested that the Detroit District study the feasibility of better managing stormwater and a solution for settling sediment out of the outflows from Greenaway Drain.

**STATUS:** A formal request to initiate a Section 205 study was submitted to the Detroit District by the City of Walled Lake on 08 July 2004. FY12 funding could be used to initiate the feasibility study to determine if indeed Federal interest in the identified flood damage reduction improvements is warranted and justified. The potential non-Federal Sponsor (NFS) has verbally been requested to provide the Corps with a more detailed project scope, such that specific needs can appropriately be addressed.
