**PROJECT:** 21st Avenue West Channel, Duluth, Minnesota - Section 204 (C-CAP)

**DESCRIPTION:** The 21st Avenue Channel was formerly part of the Federal Navigation Channel in St. Louis Bay, Duluth-Superior Harbor. This portion of the Channel has been de-authorized and the objective of the project is to create wetland habitat in this area. Dredged material from the Federal Navigation Channel would be placed at the site to create wetlands, islands and shallow pools.
