

PROJECT: Two Harbors, Minnesota - Section 107 (C-CAP)

DESCRIPTION: Two Harbors is located 28 miles northeast of Duluth, Minnesota. In 1991, the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources (MNDNR) and the North Shore Management Board selected a string of 9 harbors of refuge for small boats navigating the north shore of Lake Superior. Two Harbors would be a part of this system.
