DESCRIPTION: Algoma Harbor is located on the west shore of Lake Michigan, about 68 miles from Green Bay via Sturgeon Bay Harbor and the Lake Michigan Ship Canal and about 115 miles north of Milwaukee. This project would study key issues associated with the possible modification or repair to existing pier structures, addition of structures, increasing depth to accommodate larger vessels and all work necessary as determined by a feasibility study.
