
PROJECT INFORMATION SHEET February 2011

PROJECT: Bad River Band of Lake Superior Tribe of Chippewa Indians, Ashland County, Wisconsin - Tribal Partnership Program (C)

DESCRIPTION: The Bad River Reservation is located in Odanah, Ashland County, Wisconsin. The Bad River Reservation contains 124,474 acres composed of forests, wetlands and open water. Approximately one third of the Reservation is wetlands. These wetlands have cultural and ecological significance to the Tribe. The Bad River Band of Lake Superior Tribe of Chippewa Indians has requested the Corps to develop a watershed management plan to address ongoing degradation to the function values of these wetlands.
