**PROJECT:** Bradley Lake, Sturgeon Bay, Wisconsin - Section 206 (C-CAP)

**DESCRIPTION:** Located in Door County, Wisconsin. Bradley Lake is deteriorating to the point that only algae survive in the lake. Ducks, geese, and herons that land in the lake and feed there are dying from botulism that is occurring from unclean water, lack of water movement, and lack of oxygen within the lake. The project would restore habitat for fish, turtles, ducks, geese, muskrats, song-birds, and aquatic vegetation.
