**PROJECT:** Centerville Creek, Village of Cleveland, Wisconsin - Section 206 (C-CAP)

**DESCRIPTION:** The project would include the restoration of Centerville Creek, Manitowoc County, near the former Village of Cleveland dam site, by removing 30,000 cubic yards of excess sediment, eliminating structural barriers to fish migration, restoring riparian floodplain forest, and restoring in-channel fishery habitat features.

**STAGE:** Feasibility

**STATUS:** Because of budget constraints within the Section 206 program since FY06, the project has not been able to proceed. A concept design report was completed in 2002, and a Preliminary Restoration Plan (PRP) was started in 2003, but was never completed for the project. Anticipated FY11 Federal funding will be used to prepare a Determination of Federal Interest (DFI). If there is an indication of Federal interest, then FY12 funds would be used to update/complete the PRP and Project Management Plan for the Project.

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
