PROJECT: Frog Town Road, Baileys Harbor, WI CAP Section 14 - (C-CAP)

DESCRIPTION: Baileys Harbor is located approximately 80 miles northeast from Green Bay, WI. Frog Town Road is located along the top of a limestone bluff along the shore of Lake Michigan, in the Town of Baileys Harbor, Door County, Wisconsin. Approximately 2,000 linear feet of the road has experienced severe erosion over the past years and is now in danger of collapse. The public road serves as access for approximately 20 homes as well as providing water views for the general public.
