**PROJECT:** Green Bay Dredged Material Disposal Facility, Green Bay, Wisconsin - (C)

**DESCRIPTION:** The Green Bay Cat Island Restoration Project is located west of the mouth of the Fox River in Green Bay, Wisconsin. The project would construct three islands for the placement of dredged material from the Green Bay Navigation Channel. The project would restore and protect more than 1,000 acres of wetlands that were destroyed in the 1960s.
