PROJECT: Kinnickinnic River, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin - Section 206 (C-CAP)

DESCRIPTION: The project is located in the City of Milwaukee, Wisconsin. The proposed project involves the restoration of the Kinnickinnic River channel to a more natural stream condition with meanders, shelter areas, and riffle pool complexes. Rocky and deeper water areas would be created in order to provide refuge for fish to feed and rest. The upstream project limit is located approximately 700 feet north of the Jackson Park Drive culvert (near Jackson Park Lagoon) and extends approximately 5,800 linear feet downstream to South 27th Street.
