**PROJECT:** Lake Poygan, Winnebago County, Wisconsin - Section 1135 (C-CAP)

**DESCRIPTION:** Lake Poygan is an impoundment on the Wolf River in Central Wisconsin. Lake Poygan once provided abundant high quality habitat for waterfowl and other birds, furbearers, and diverse warm water fishery. Much of this habitat has deteriorated in recent years. The Corps regulates water levels in the lake and the sponsor contends that high water levels and wave action have negatively impacted plant communities. The project would involve the construction of a breakwall on Lake Poygan for the purpose of protecting, improving, and restoring fish and other aquatic wildlife habitat.
