PROJECT: Lower Menomonee, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin - Section 206 (C-CAP)

DESCRIPTION: The Lower Menomonee River Valley area is in the center of Milwaukee, Wisconsin, extending from the mouth of the Menomonee River where it joins the Milwaukee River, to approximately River Mile 4.0, where the river crosses Bluemound Road. The project area is within the Milwaukee Estuary Area of Concern. The project would restore over 1 mile of the aquatic ecosystem to more natural in-stream condition with meanders, shelter areas, and riffle pool complexes.
