**DESCRIPTION:** The Manitowoc Harbor is located in Wisconsin along the west shore of Lake Michigan approximately 79 miles north of Milwaukee and about 106 miles from Sturgeon Bay Harbor and the Lake Michigan Ship Canal. This project involves a reevaluation study to dredge the harbor in Manitowoc, Wisconsin. The funding would be used to determine the economic, engineering, and environmental feasibility of this authorized project under the 2007 Water Resources and Development Act, and to identify a potential non-federal sponsor.
