DESCRIPTION: The Manitowoc River and Harbor are located in Wisconsin along the west shore of Lake Michigan approximately 79 miles north of Milwaukee and about 106 miles from Sturgeon Bay Harbor and the Lake Michigan Ship Canal. WRDA 2007 authorized the deepening of this harbor.
