**PROJECT:** Milwaukee Harbor South Shore Breakwater, WI - Section 107 (C-CAP)

**DESCRIPTION:** Milwaukee Harbor is located on the west shore of Lake Michigan about 85 miles north of Chicago, IL. Milwaukee Harbor serves the metropolitan area in many ways and is an important factor in the local economy. Given the growth of the area since the harbor authorizations, and how the evolving sediment transport concerns along the Lake Michigan shoreline impacts dredging; potential modification of existing harbor features could help to improve navigation. This project would study key issues associated with rehabilitation of the South Shore Breakwater including feasibility, sediment transport, and impacts on water quality.
