

PROJECT: Northern Wisconsin Environmental Assistance, Wisconsin - Section 154 (C)

DESCRIPTION: The Northern Wisconsin Environmental Infrastructure Assistance area includes the counties of Ashland, Bayfield, Douglas, and Iron. The program area includes a significant area of the shoreline of Lake Superior and the Upper Mississippi River watersheds. The program provides assistance to northern Wisconsin public entities in the “form of design, construction and reconstruction assistance for water-related environmental infrastructure and resource protection and development projects in northern Wisconsin, including projects for navigation and inland harbor improvement and expansion, wastewater treatment and related facilities, water supply and related facilities, environmental restoration, and surface water resource protection and development.”

STAGE: Construction

STATUS: FY12 funds would be used to assist other communities that are selected for funding by the Project Selection Committee. Fifteen potential projects were selected by the Project Selection Committee in Nov 2010 for any FY11 funding (11 of these 15 potential projects are in Detroit District, and 4 are in St Paul District). In Detroit District, three Project Partnering Agreements (PPAs) have been executed in FY11, nine PPAs were executed in FY10, and seven PPAs & one amendment were executed in FY09. One more PPA could be executed in FY11 from prior year funding, after adequate information is provided by the local sponsor.

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
