PROJECT: Oneida Nation of Wisconsin - PAS (I)

DESCRIPTION: The Oneida Nation is approximately 105 square miles in Brown and Outagamie Counties in Northeast Wisconsin by Green Bay, Wisconsin. Historically FEMA has not delineated flood maps for Indian Reservations, nor perform hydraulic or hydrology analysis for flood studies on Indian Reservations. The Detroit District was requested by the Oneida Nation to perform such studies and delineate flood maps for the reservation. This is an ongoing multi-year endeavor.
