PROJECT: Wilson Park Creek, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin - Section 206 (C-CAP)

DESCRIPTION: The project is located in the City of Milwaukee, Wisconsin. The proposed project is the restoration of approximately 5,000 linear feet of stream bank including the removal of approximately 2,700 linear feet of concrete channel. The upstream limit of the project is located at West Layton Avenue and the downstream limit is the CP Railroad crossing. Restoration efforts would be for the purpose of restoring the areas aquatic ecosystem habitat to a more natural setting through the addition of natural stream features (meanders, shelter areas, and deep riffle pool complexes).
