



Section 404
 Discharge of Dredged or Fill Material
 Regulated Waters Definition: 33 CFR 328.3(a)

Examples of Regulated Activities:
 All filling and grading activities, mechanized land clearing, beach nourishment, sidecasting/disposal of dredge material, riprap, backfilling, temporary fills, and some excavation activities.

Section 10
 All Structures and Work
 Regulated Waters Definition: 33 CFR 329.4


Examples of Regulated Activities:
 Dredging, marinas, piers, floats/docks, hoists, buoys, intake/outfall pipes, pilings, bulkheads, ramps, fills, and overhead transmission lines that occur within, over, under, or affecting the waterbody.
