I found wetlands 1, 2, 3, 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10 were isolated--all of these systems were basically "pothole" wetlands with muck soils or near-muck soils that had no natural or man-made outlets. None of these wetlands could be considered adjacent to other waters. Collectively, the wetlands comprised 8.51 acres
