I-RAP Burnham Canal, Milwaukee Harbor, WI

Project Location: The project location is a former navigation channel in the Milwaukee Estuary, within Milwaukee, WI.

Project Description: Through the Remedial Action Plan (RAP) Program, the Non-Federal Sponsor has asked for assistance with Plans and Specifications to design a near shore wetland habitat in a former navigation channel in Milwaukee Estuary Area of Concern (AOC). U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) provided the design to cap the contaminated sediment base with an impermeable cap and create a wetland habitat environment. Project execution will be by Non-Federal Sponsor. This project is authorized under Section 401(a) of the Water Resources Development Act of 1990, as amended – Remedial Action Plans (RAP).

Non-Federal Partner: Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District (MMSD)

Project Benefits: Restores 5 acres of near shore habitat suitable for Northern Pike Spawning.

Project Status: FY17 funds were used to complete the design in October 2017. Construction will be 100% funded and executed by the Non-Federal Sponsor.
