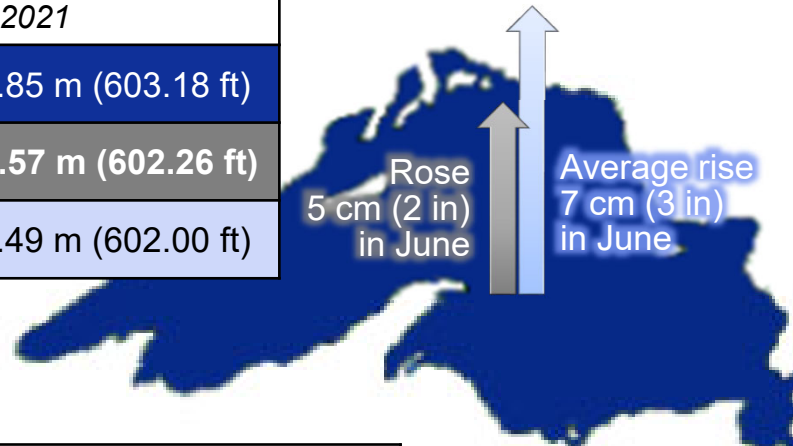


Lake Superior Water Level <i>Beginning of July 2021</i>

Average (1918-2020)	183.49 m (602.00 ft)

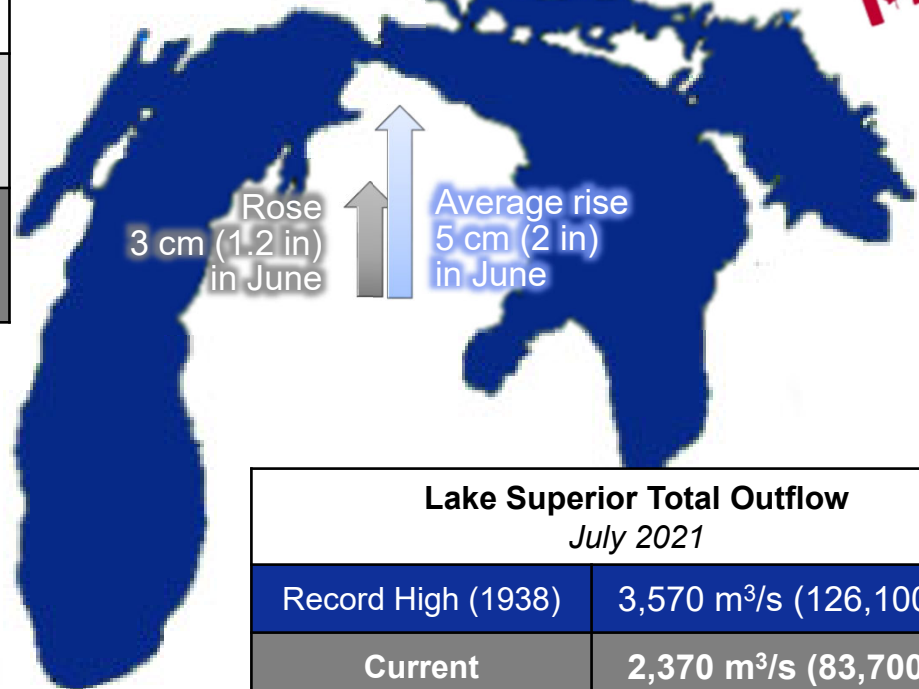
Forecast Outlook
Weather and water supply conditions were dry again in June. The lakes typically rise in July. Depending on the weather and water supply conditions during the next month, the lakes may continue rising or decline slightly in July.
