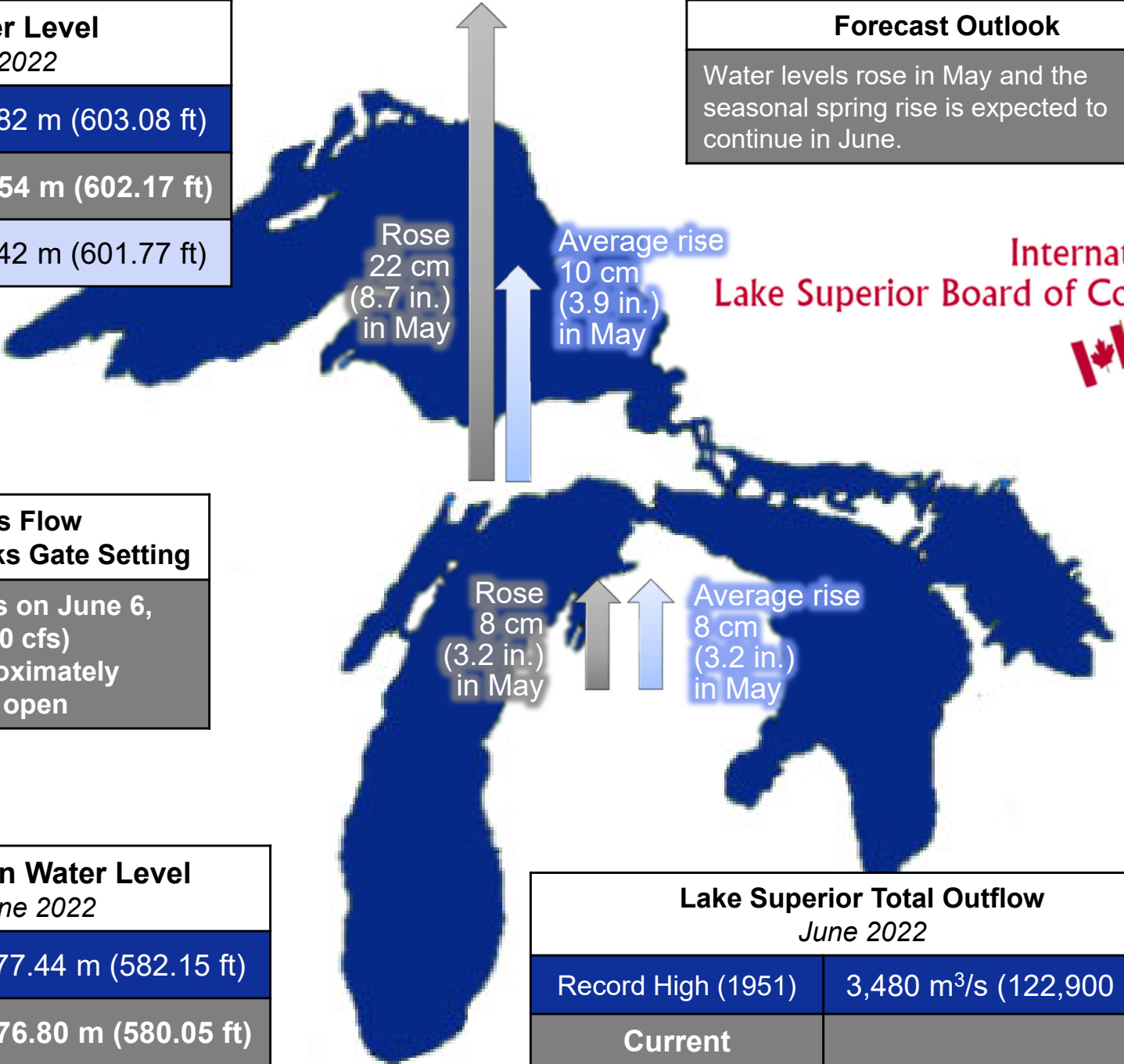


Lake Superior Water Level <i>Beginning of June 2022</i>
