
Project Location: Duluth-Superior, MN-WI

Project Description: The Corps will remove sediment from within the Federal Navigation Channel in the Duluth-Superior Harbor and place the material at sites designed for habitat restoration. Material will be placed in accordance with the aquatic habitat restoration design developed under the St. Louis River Area of Concern Remedial Action Plan. In 2018 GLRI (Great Lakes Restoration Initiative) Funds may be used to dredge and place 15,000 CY (Cubic Yards) in the 40th West Site This project is authorized under Operations and Maintenance. Project Benefits: The placement of dredge material will create optimal water depths to promote the growth of aquatic vegetation in support of a healthy benthic community and robust fishery
