Throughout the City of Charlevoix, several source contaminant plumes have been identified. Investigation to track the migration of the contaminated material from the identified sources and develop an action plan to remediate the contamination that has infiltrated the ground water. Several monitoring wells are being installed, vapor intrusion tests and ground water samples are being collected. FY17 funds were used to continue this investigation and start a final report.
