IIS-G&H Landfill Macomb County, MI

Description

G&H Landfill is located in Macomb County MI. about 20 miles north of Detroit. The site comprises approximately 60 acres of former landfill, 30 acres of adjacent wetlands, and other impacted areas. The site is bound on the north by 23 Mile Road and on the east by Ryan Road. The Clinton River runs through the Rochester-Utica State Recreational Area to the south and west of the site. U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) is providing technical oversight of the potential responsible parties implementation of the corrective action plan to improve hydraulic control and collection system and the potential installation of a 1300' slurry wall to improve leachate collection at the landfill.
