# Description

The Site is located at 28000 River Road in Gibraltar, Wayne County, Michigan. U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) provides technical assistance with remedial investigation, evaluation, proposal, selection and work plans for response actions at the DSC McLouth Gibraltar Steel Superfund Site (Detroit Steel Company, DSC). The primary objective is to evaluate current conditions, develop detailed work plans, and provide oversight of contracts to complete the work and ensure that remediation work is in compliance with and meets the requirements of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA), the National Oil and Hazardous Substances Contingency Plan (NCP) and U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) guidance.
