IIS-Keweenaw Stamp Sands, Gay, MI

Description

The project is located in the Keweenaw Peninsula, between Gay, MI and the Grand Traverse Harbor. FY17 / FY18 funds will be used to award a dredging contract that will remove approximately 30,000 cubic yards of stamp sands in Grand Traverse Harbor area and an additional 172,000 cubic yards in the trough area adjacent to the Buffalo Reef in order to delay further sedimentation by the littoral drift in the stamp sands into the reef and the juvenile white fish recruitment area south of the harbor.
