Description

The project consists of constructing a Surge Basin adjacent to the Gary Sanitary Lift Station to accept high flows during storm events. Following the peak event, the Lift Station will then regulate flow from the basin into the sanitary sewer system for treatment. Construction of this Surge Basin will prevent system overflows, thereby reducing the threat to human health and the environment.
