Description

The Pike River is located in the Village of Somers, approximately 15 miles southwest of Racine, Wisconsin and approximately 25 miles south-southwest of Milwaukee, Wisconsin. The South Branch Pike River is located in a rapidly urbanizing watershed with substantial urban and agricultural lands. The river exhibits flashy and powerful discharges with significant aggradations and degradation of the streambed and the surrounding wetlands. Bank stability is low and there is high potential for erosion events during high flow conditions. The purpose of the project is to restore approximately 4 miles of river through natural stream features (meanders, shelter areas, and deep riffle pool complexes) and prairie and wetlands in selected reaches; to enhance aquatic habitat; improve overall water quality with significant reductions in nitrogen, phosphorous and sediment loading.
