C. Additional comments to support AJD: Area shows up on NWI as wetland and the soils for this area are mapped as a muck. However an on-site investigation (data sheets included) revealed that neither of these are correct. The soils are a loam with non-hydric colors. The vegetation was dominated by Phalaris arundinance (Reed Canary Grass) the other emergent vegetation were common milkweed (Asclepias syriaca) and Kentucky bluegrass (Poa pratensis). Site is upland at the same elevation as homes on either side.
