C. Additional comments to support AJD: The emergent wetland labeled Section I (0.02 acres) on the attached report is located within an open field with forest to the north and west, open field to the south and open field and highway to the east. Based on review of applicable resources and a site visit, the geographic location of Section I wetland in relation to the closest waterway (Graham McCulloch ditch) does not meet wetland adjacency criteria since the wetland does not abut an (a)(1)-(a)(3) water and is not physically separated by a natural feature from an (a)(1)-(a)(3) water. Based on site review, it has been determined that Section I wetland is also not physically separated from a (a)(1)-(a)(3) water by an artificial structure, dike barrier, etc. that has a direct hydrologic connection in a typical year. Section 1 wetland is not inundated by flood water in a typical year from an (a)(1)-(a)(3) water. The wetland is located approximately 1.4 miles from the Graham McCulloch Ditch (closest water/tributary) and is outside of the mapped floodzone, which supports that Section 1 wetland would not be subject to inundation by flooding in a typical year.

The area labeled Pond (2.40 acres) on the attached report was excavated for recreational purposes in non-hydric soils. According to aerial imagery, the pond was excavated between 1957 and 1964. Based on review of applicable materials, the Pond is not inundated by flood water in a typical year from an (a)(1)-(a)(3) water. The pond meets the (b)(8) exclusion, an artificial lake/pond constructed or excavated in upland or a non-jurisdictional water. Based on 1957, 1964 and 2019 aerials a feature potentially meeting the definition of a tributary was not observed, thus the pond is not an impoundment of a jurisdictional water meeting conditions of paragraph (c)(6).
