Wetland A	~1.0	acre(s)	(b)(1) Non-adjacent wetland.	There are no tributaries near the wetland identified as Wetland A, the closest identified tributary is 0.6 miles to the east of the wetland. The geographic location of the wetland in relation to the tributary does not meet wetland adjacency criteria since the wetland does not abut an (a)(1)-(a)(3) water and is not physically separated by a natural feature from an (a)(1) - (a)(3). Wetland A is also not physically separated from an (a)(1) - (a)(3) water by an artificial structure, dike barrier, etc., that has a direct hydrologic connection, this is based on the site review. Wetland A is also not inundated by floodwater in a typical year from an (a)(1) –(a)(3) water, Wetland A is located outside the mapped floodplain. Based on the FEMA flood map the area is listed as an “area of minimal flood hazard”. Based on the geographic distance and annual flood chance, Wetland A would not be subject to inundation by flooding in a typical year.
